


POSCO Global Young Leaders Program fall'23 - SPRING'24

POSCO Group's overseas subsidiaries are to select undergraduate students fromtop universities in their host country, where the selected students will be given opportunities to take courses and participate in research in POSTECH as well as experience Korean culture and the POSCO industry. All expenses throughout the stay in Korea will be covered by POSCO. Once the program has been completed, the alumni of GYP are to serve as POSCO global ambassadors equipped with POSCO global corporate citizen spirit in their home country.

Application Guide

Academic Programs

GYP participants will be able to take part in course-taking credit exchange, research participation (non-credit), Korean language courses and cultural programs, tour of POSCO, etc. Upon selection, students will be placed into one of the following undergraduate programs at POSTECH:

Physics	Life Sciences
Electrical Engineering	Chemical Engineering
Convergence IT Engineering	Computer Science & Engineering
Materials Science & Engineering	Mechanical Engineering

Eligibility Requirements

- Second or third year undergraduate student enrolled at & nominated by POSTECH's partner university
- GPA average above 3.3/4.3
- Equivalent English proficiency certification scores of TOEFL iBT 90, IELTS 6.5 or above

Scholarship & Benefits

Students selected for GYP will receive full coverage of their round-trip flights to/from Korea and visa-related fees, as well as a monthly scholarship (1,000,000 KRW/monthe, quivalent to approximately 750 USD) from POSCO. Participants who decide to drop out of the GYP before program completion may be required to return the scholarship.

Academic Calendar & Overall Timeline

GYP is a year-long program which will operate from 2023 Fall Semester to 2024 Spring Semester (September 2023 – June 2024). Key program dates and timeline are as follows:

- Application Deadline : May 31
- Document Evaluation: May 31 June 2
- Candidate Interview (in-person or online): June 7 14
- Admission Announcement: June 15
- Korean Language Course (online): July 1 31 - Arrival in Korea: August 21 - 25

* The dates may change due to unforeseen circumstances.

Supporting Documents

- Application Form (signed by the university's international exchange coordinator)
- Statement of Purpose (attached form)
- Official Academic Transcript in English - Recommendation Letter from Home University
- Certified Score of English Proficiency
- Copy of Passport (scanned; passport must be valid for at least six months from visa issuance)

All student applications and supporting documents should be collected and sent to POSTECH via e-mail at iao@postech.ac.kr by each university's international program coordinator by the relevant deadline.
