1. Criteria

- Non-Thai Nationality and have no residence in Thailand
- A Bachelor's Degree in any field with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 and above from an accredited university. All scholarship applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and above.
- Requirement for English Proficiency does not apply for native English speakers.
- Students with an International Bachelor's Degree Program are not required to submit official evidence of English Proficiency test score upon application submission

2. Other Specific Eligibility Criteria

Selection Criteria

1. Language Proficiency Test TOEFL = (iBT) 61 IELTS = 6.0 TU-GET = (PBT) 500
On Conditions: TOEFL = (iBT) 32 IELTS = 4.5 TU-GET = (PBT) 400

Requirement Documents:

- 2 copies of bachelor's degree Graduate Certificate
- Educational Qualification Verification Form (need to be fill and verified by your university together with University's seal) *as per attached
- 2 copies of Original Transcript
- 1 copy of Passport
- Certificate of Medical Examination (including drug test) indicating that you are in good health and your health will not hinder your studies
- 1 copy of valid English Proficiency Test Result (Please bring the original copy as well)
- 1 copy of Certificate of name change (if any)
- ID Photos: 2 Photos of 1.5 inch (passport size) and 1 photo of 1 inch (small size for Student Card) taken within 6 months (You may want to bring more photos for later use)
