1. Criteria

- Non-Thai Nationality and have no residence in Thailand
- Applicants must have completed high school Grade 12 or an equivalent.
- Applicants must complete General Education Development (GED).
 - Applicants taking the GED tests before May 2017 shall have GED results in 5 subjects, scoring at least 410 in each subject.
 - Applicants taking the GED tests since May 2017 BE onwards shall have GED results in 4 subjects, scoring at least 145 in each subject.
- Applicants who expected to graduate or haven't received a high school certificate, or an equivalent by the time of the admission. The applicants can submit the certificate within 31 July 2024 or the date set by the Thammasat University.
